The Club Safeguarding Lead's terms of reference include:

- Maintaining an up to date policy and procedures, compatible with advice from the RYA.
- Ensuring that relevant staff and/or volunteers are aware of and follow the procedures, including implementing safe recruitment procedures.
- Advising the General Committee on child protection issues.
- Maintaining contact details for local Children's Social Care Services* and Police.

Where there is a concern, the Club Safeguarding Lead will:

- Be the first point of contact for any concerns or allegations, from children or adults, ensuring that confidentiality is maintained in all cases.
- Advise on the appropriate action to be taken, in line with the club's procedures and in conjunction with the person in charge (Commodore, Vice Commodore etc).
- Keep the RYA informed as necessary

Everyone in Wivenhoe Sailing Club should know who the Safeguarding Lead is and how to contact them.

Any member of the club failing to comply with the Safeguarding policy or any relevant Codes of Conduct may be subject to disciplinary action under Wivenhoe Sailing Club rules.
