

Guidance – Use of WSC premises

Your Committee has agreed to adopt the RYA Guiding Principles

We will always try to follow Government advice. The COVID-19 preventative measures are vital to protecting health and wellbeing and to minimising pressure on frontline services. We all have a role to play by following the Government guidelines.

We will, as a boating club, take a considerate and conservative approach.

Considerate: We will be mindful of the potential impact that we could have on other water users and do not place unnecessary extra strain on the RNLI and emergency services.

Conservative: We will help to minimise risk by taking an extra conservative approach to our boating.

Your Committee has approved the following guidance to members.

1. The clubhouse building will not be open.
2. Members MUST NOT attend the club if they are showing any symptoms of COVID-19, or have been asked to self-isolate.
3. Members are responsible for their own adherence to social distancing guidelines when on club premises.
4. Members may carry out essential checks and maintenance on their boats, either as individuals or as a group from the same household.
5. Whilst canoes, rowing boats, sailing dinghies, etc. may be used in public spaces, unfortunately at present the advice is, access to the water is not permitted from any sailing club premises.
6. The visitor's pontoon will be shut as overnight stays are not permitted.
